Let us hold one another in prayer and be gracious toward each other in the coming months. I believe great things are in store for Center Church.

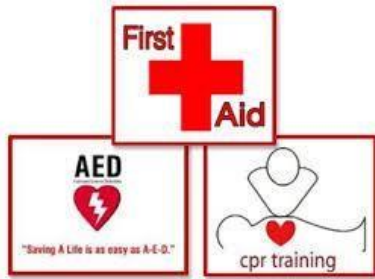

OUTREACH MINISTRIES UPDATE

Summer is a time of relaxing, when people can slow down and visit somewhere they find rejuvenating. Unfortunately, life's hardships don't take a vacation and we were as busy as ever these past couple months. During the months of July and August, we served 23 people in need of security deposit or rental assistance and 6 in need of help with utilities. We had 73 volunteers log 216 volunteers hours and serve 451 meals. During this time, we received two notes of appreciation. One was from a couple in their 20s who had been sleeping in Keney Park for a week. We helped purchase bus tickets for them to reconnect with family in New York. The other came from a mother and her two sons, who were homeless. They needed two additional nights in a hotel while another organization found them longer-term resources. We were happy to help, and if you look at the picture next to this article, you will see they were quite happy too.

FAITH FORMATION UPDATE

As you know, our summer has included the resignation of Jana and Anne Russo-Priestley as our Children and Youth Faith Formation staff. We are sorry to lose them and excited for their next adventure as foster parents to infant twins! We will celebrate their ministries among us on September 16 after worship.
