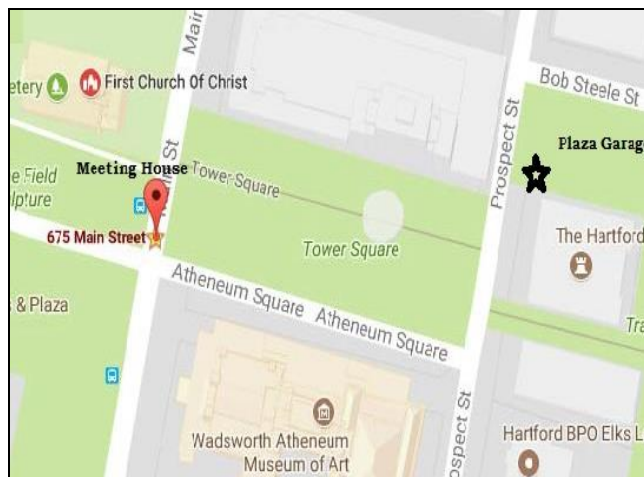




About Our Series
