



The purpose of a one-on-one conversation, and it is a conversation, is to have a deeper understanding of the person with whom you are speaking. While we sometimes resist the urge to "pry" or "be too personal," a one-on-one conversation is an invitation to do just that. Lean into the discomfort of being vulnerable and allow yourself to tell your story, your lived experience and open yourself up to allowing others to tell you theirs.

# Some prompts that might help start your conversations:

WHY do you come to church? WHY are you part of this community?
WHAT gets you out of bed each morning and WHY?
WHAT are you living for? WHAT is getting in the way of that?

# Some things to keep in mind about 1-on-1 conversation

### One on One Conversations ARE

- a conversation, an encounter
- mutual
- moving to the center of a person
- purposeful & intentional
- exploratory & relational
- public
- about gifts, talents, passions, strengths
- <u>about developing a relationship</u>

### One on One Conversations ARE NOT

- an interview or chit chat
- unidirectional
- superficial or random
- accidental
- a sales pitch/signup
- private
- about need
- about getting information
- interminable or drop-in

If you enjoyed the conversation that you had today, reach out to your conversation partner and continue the conversation outside of worship. If you are interested in having conversations with other members of our community, walk across the room and invite someone you do not know very well or someone who you think you know well but have not connected with in a while into conversation after worship, or outside of worship this week. If we are to be a thriving community, it is vital to engage in relationship building from within as well as without.
