SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Pastor: Members and friends in Christ, we gather now to celebrate the gift of grace in the

sacrament of baptism.

People: There is one body and one Spirit. There is one hope in God's call to us.

Pastor: Jesus came to John to be baptized by him but John tried to make him change his

mind. "I ought to be baptized by you," John said, "yet you have come to me!"

People: Jesus said, "Let it be so for now. For in this way, we shall do all that God

requires." So John agreed.

Pastor: As soon as Jesus was baptized, he came up out of the water. Then heaven was

opened to him, and he saw the Spirit of God coming down like a dove and lighting

on him.

People: Then a voice said from heaven, "This is my own dear Son, with whom I am well

pleased."

Pastor: At another time, Jesus said, "Go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in

the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

Baptism is the sacrament through which we are united to Jesus Christ and given part in Christ's ministry of reconciliation. Baptism is a visible sign of an invisible event: the reconciliation of people to God. It shows the death of self and the rising to a life of obedience and praise. It shows also the pouring out of the Holy Spirit of those whom God has chosen. In baptism, God works in us the power of forgiveness, the renewal of the Spirit, and the knowledge of the call to be God's people always.

People: This is the water of baptism. Out of this water, we rise with new life, forgiven of

sin and one in Christ, members of Christ's body.
