

# From the Visionary Team Fall Updates

The Visionary Team has identified three areas for our community to focus on in the coming program year, based on notes from our May church retreat:

- Increase the engagement of children in worship in multiple ways.
- Create a short-term Faith Formation Strategy Team to create a vision for our ministries with children and youth. The team would work starting in September, would make budget recommendations for the congregational budget meeting in November, and would report to the congregation at our Annual Meeting next spring. We commissioned this working group in worship on Sunday. They will have their first meeting this week and will meet regularly through November.
- Start a small group to move forward with exploring the creation of a 501(c)(3) that will help support our ministries with folks in transition. This group will be meeting in the coming weeks to develop a timeline for the scope of their commission.

#### A GHIAA Call to Action - Immigrant Protections



This week, GHIAA was one of over 90 organizations who signed on to a <u>letter</u> to our elected officials, calling on them to prioritize protecting

immigrants by passing specific legislative priorities in this fall's special session. These demands were also highlighted during our <u>solidarity</u> <u>vigil</u> last week in Newington, with over 500 people present and lots of supportive honking from drivers passing by on Main Street.

We need you to amplify this call by contacting Governor Lamont, Speaker Ritter, and Senator Looney, urging them to take action on this legislation in the special session, using the phone numbers and script below. You can also help by sharing the press release and letter linked above with your state rep and senator, urging their support of these priorities as well.

Study after study has presented reasons why churches in the United States are in a state of decline. And yet, there is a deep need for spiritual community and the Church to function well in our rapidly evolving world.

Dr. Ruth A. Fletcher researched hundreds of congregations and wrote a book entitled, *Thrive: Spiritual Habits of Transforming Congregations.* 

In the book she presents words, images, and stories of how congregations transform into what were churches in decline or plateaued into thriving communities of faith.

This fall we will spend 4 weeks diving into her 4 major themes for transforming congregations: *Connect with the Spirit, Connect with Purpose, Connect with Community, and Connect with the World*. Together, we will imagine new ways for our community not just to survive, but to Thrive in the HART of this city.




