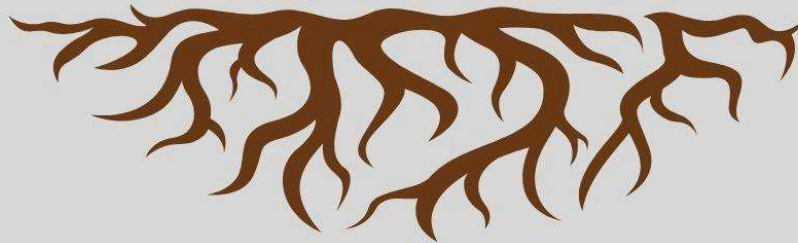

From the Property Subcommittee *Spring Updates*

Warm Greetings Center Church,

We recently met with Tim Brewer and his architectural firm to review schematic drawings and a short list of would-be Construction Managers. We invite you to review the schematics, attached below, and which will be made available in the Meetinghouse for review after worship for the next several weeks.

A short but incomplete list of the scope of the project includes:

- Repairs and Maintenance to the Slate Roof
- Structural and Cosmetic Repairs to the Meetinghouse Roofline
- Masonry and Drainage Deterioration along the Northside of the Meetinghouse

We are currently using Capital Improvement Funds to finance the preliminary stages of our project but as more information becomes available about the full scope and cost of the project, we anticipate fundraising efforts that include grant writing, outside donations and a thorough exploration of other revenue streams.

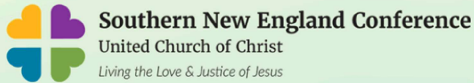

Thank you to all our friends and community partners who helped make a successful event this Wednesday, May 13th.

Nearly fifty academics, institutional representatives, historic partners and descendants of historical figures attended our symposium, MC'd by History Team Chair, Andre Keitt.

At the event Center Church Historian Alvin Thompson gave a historical overview; Brother Eric presented new research findings; Greenberg fellow Henry Graf presented his paper on the American Colonization Society; Mr. Jeff Bravin, of the American School for the Deaf, and Ms. Reanna Kudzal, of the Greenberg Center at Trinity College, shared greetings from their respective organizations; HRH Karen Brengettsy-Chatman, President of the Official Royal House of Sori and CEO of the Root Nine Foundation and Institute, read from her recently published book. Afterward, a number of attendees toured the Teacher's Library and stayed for lunch.

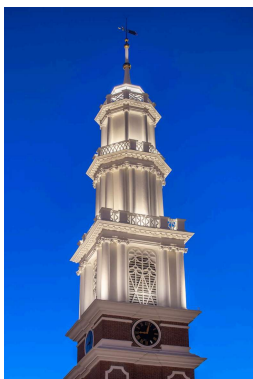

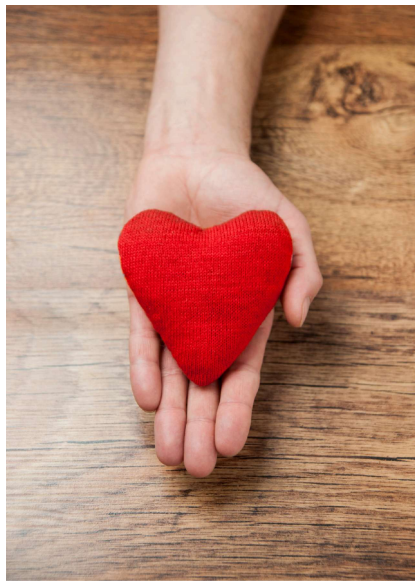
